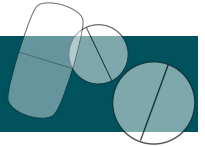

Effective November 1, Innoviant is making two changes to our pharmacy network: adding the Prescription Solutions Specialty Pharmacy and removing CuraScript.

Prescriptions dispensed by CuraScript after October 31 will no longer process at the point-of-sale. This may result in some member disruption; however, Innoviant is proactively taking steps to minimize these instances.

Open refills for specialty medications will transfer from CuraScript to Prescription Solutions. Innoviant is contacting affected members via mail to notify them of the transition and let them know they do not need to get new prescriptions from their doctors. Also, when the refill transfer occurs, Prescription Solutions will automatically register members and reach out to them to ensure they continue receiving their medications as scheduled.

In a separate mailing, Innoviant is also contacting members currently using CuraScript to fill prescriptions for non-specialty medications. They will be able to choose between filling these prescriptions via the Innoviant Rx mail order pharmacy service or at an in-network retail pharmacy. With either option, these members must obtain new written prescriptions from their physicians. The notification letters will include an Innoviant Rx registration/order form. Depending on plan design, members choosing the mail order option may experience the benefit of getting up to a 90-day supply of non-specialty medications delivered right to their homes.
